Immigration:

Data from the U.S. Census Bureau for 2011-2015 indicate that 60,858 people or 8.24% of the population living in this area were "foreign born". Census defines foreign born as anyone who is not a U.S. citizen at birth. This area is located in Texas, which, according to the Department of Homeland Security, was home to 95,295 people who were granted Legal Permanent Residence status in 2014. Those LPRs, or "green cards", represent 9.37% of green cards issued in the nation that year.

Vacancy:

There were an estimated 297,747 housing units in the study area in 2011-2015, according to the Census' American Community Survey. For 2011-2015, the Census showed an estimated 12.61% of housing units to be vacant, compared to 11.22% in the state of Texas.
